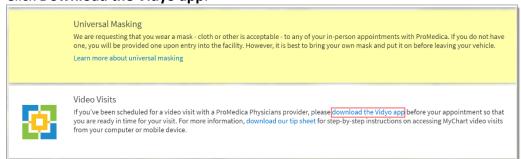
You can log in to your visit up to 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time and up to 30 minutes after their scheduled time.



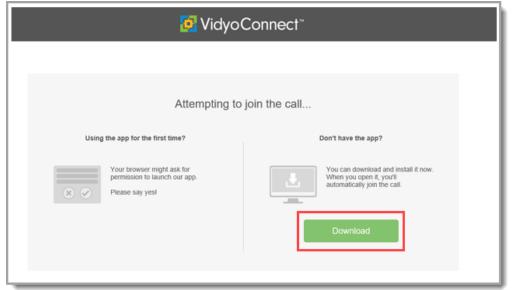
If the connection is lost, you can go back into MyChart and click Begin Visit again.

MyChart on Computer

- 1. Log in to MyChart via your computer.
- 2. Click Download the Vidyo app.

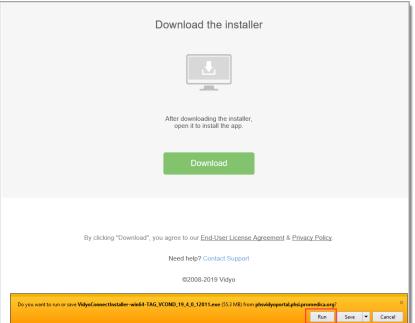


3. The VidyoConnect application will open, click Download.

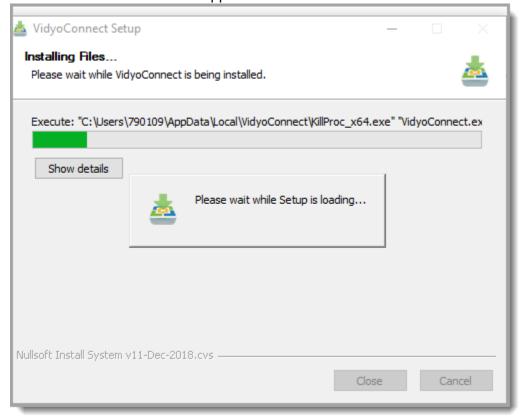




4. Click **Run** at the bottom of the page. The application will download.

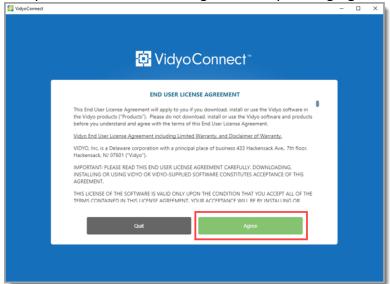


5. The file download screen will appear. Allow the download to run.

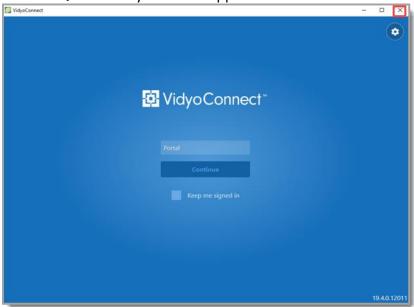




6. Accept the End User License Agreement by clicking Agree.



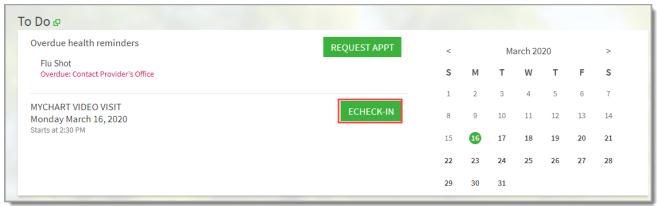
7. Exit and Quit the VidyoConnect application.



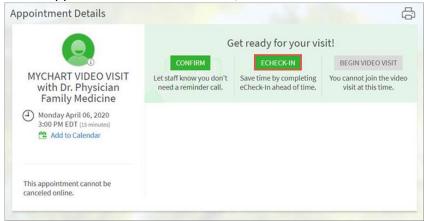
8. Navigate back to MyChart.



9. Under the To Do section, you will see your appointment list and click on **ECHECK-IN** for the MyChart Video Visit.



10. In the Appointment Details window, click ECHECK-IN.

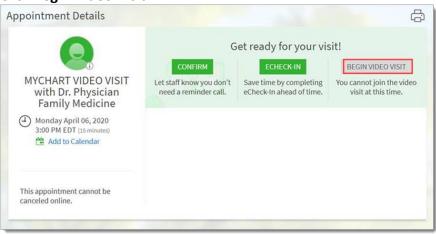


11. After you complete registration, click Begin Video Visit.



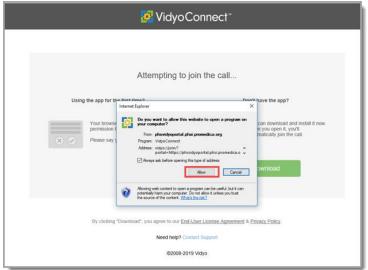
You can log in to your visit up to 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time. If you try to register too early, the Begin Video Visit button will be grayed out.

12. Click Begin Video Visit.



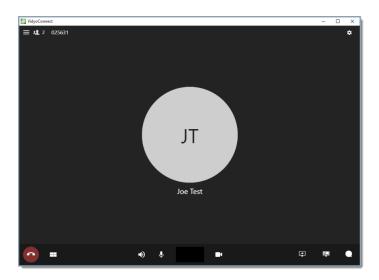


13. Click **Allow** to launch VidyoConnect.



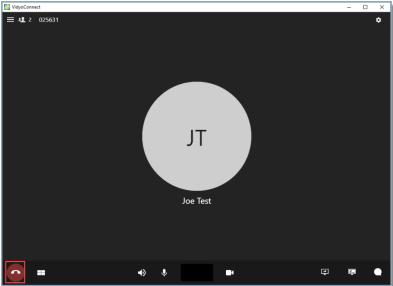
14. Your name will appear. Click Join to connect to the provider.







15. When the call is complete, click the leave the call button.

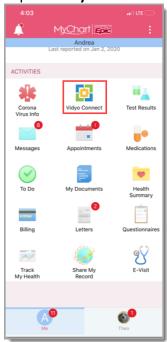




MyChart on Mobile Apps

Apple Mobile App

- 1. Download MyChart from the App Store.
- 2. Log in to MyChart.
- 3. Tap the Vidyo Connect icon to download the Vidyo Connect app.

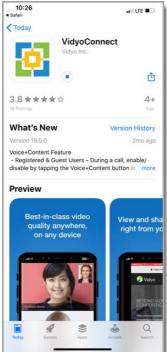


4. Tap Continue to download the app.





5. The AppStore will open and you will need to download the VidyoConnect app.



6. Navigate back to the MyChart app and tap eCheck-In.





7. Once eCheck-In is complete, tap Begin Visit.

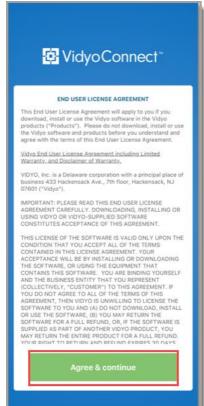


8. Tap Join the Call.





9. Accept the End User License Agreement by tapping the Agree & continue button.



10. Tap **OK** on all the access request screens.







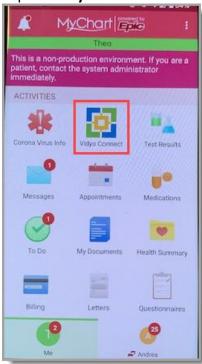
- 12. If any other access requests appear, the patient will need to tap OK.
- 13. When the visit is complete, tap the end call button.





Android Mobile App

- 1. Download MyChart from the Play Store.
- 2. Log in to MyChart.
- 3. Tap the Vidyo Connect icon to download the app.

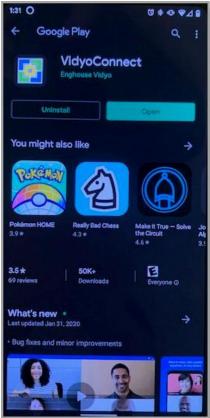


4. Tap **Continue** to download the app.





5. Download the VidyoConnect app from Google Play.



6. Navigate back to the MyChart app and tap the Video Visit.





7. Tap Begin Visit.

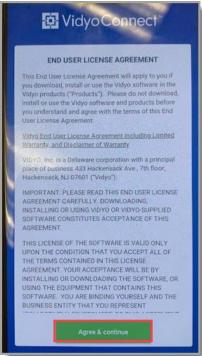


8. Tap Join.

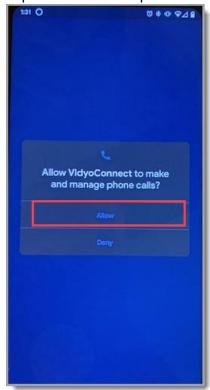




9. Accept the End User License Agreement by tapping Agree & continue.

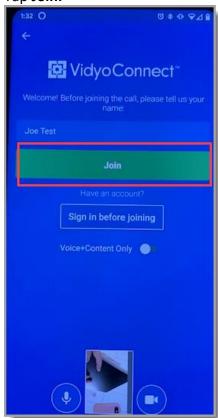


10. Tap **Allow** on all the permission screens.





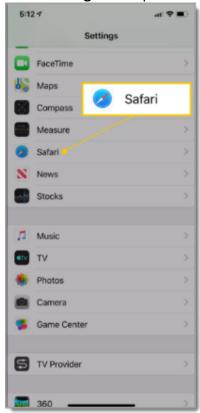
11. Tap Join.





Troubleshooting

- 1. Pop-up blocker needs disabled on iPhone or iPad.
 - a. Go to Settings and tap Safari.



b. In the general section, toggle off **Block Pop-ups.**

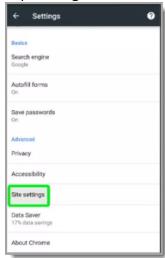




- 2. Pop-up blocker needs disabled on Android.
 - **a.** Navigate to **Chrome** and tap the 3 vertical dots in the top right corner.



b. Tap Settings and scroll to Site Settings.



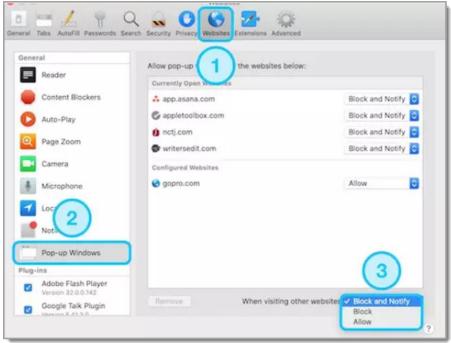


c. Tap Pop-ups and toggle off Pop-ups.



3. Pop-up blocker needs disabled on MAC computer.

- a. Launch Safari.
- **b.** In the menu bar, go to **Safari** > **Preferences** or use the key command: **₩.**
- **c.** Go to the **Websites** tab and select **Pop-up Windows** from the sidebar.
- **d.** Choose the pop-up settings for any currently open or previously edited websites.
- e. Choose Safari's default pop-up where it says: When visiting other websites.
- **f.** Select the **Allow option** for sites you want pop-ups to appear and choose **Block and Notify** for all others (you can change this setting later for sites you want to allow).
- g. Close out of Safari and relaunch Safari.





4. The video quality is poor.

a. Are devices that are being used connected to WIFI? If yes, are there several other devices connected to WIFI. For example, is Netflix streaming? If other devices are connected, try to disconnect them to see if that makes the video quality better.

5. Mobile video/audio issues.

a. Make sure that you accept all of the permission requests that display when downloading the VidyoConnect App.

6. Minimum OS requirements for Android and IOS.

a. The VidyoMobile[™] for iOS app is available as a free download on the Apple App Store, and has been tested and certified on the following iOS devices:

iPhone®	5, 5C, 5S, 6, 6 Plus, 6S, 6S Plus, 7, 7 Plus, SE
iPod touch®	4th and 5th generation
iPad®	3 rd , 4 th , iPad Air®, iPad Air2, iPad mini2 TM , iPad mini3, iPad Pro®

All devices require iOS 7.1 or later.

7. Download VidyoConnect prior to video visit.

a. You can download here: https://phsvidyoportal.phsi.promedica.org/.

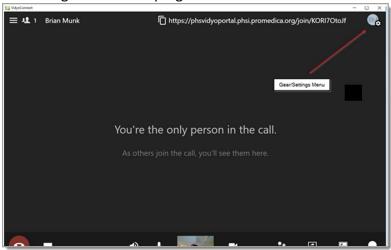
8. You receive a window asking your for the portal address.

a. Close out of the VidyoConnect app and open the MyChart app to continue the echeck-in process.

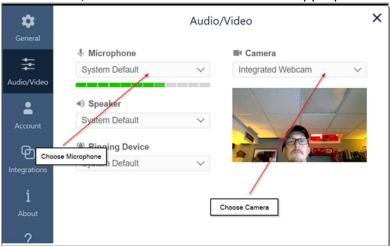


9. How to change your camera and microphone device in VidyoConnect.

a. Click the gears in the top right-hand corner of the screen.



b. Select Audio/Video on the left and select the appropriate camera and audio.



10. One side of the VidyoConnect has video and the other side does not.

- a. It is likely that there is a poor network connection. Are devices that are being used connected to WIFI? If yes, are there several other devices connected to WIFI. For example, is Netflix streaming? If other devices are connected, try to disconnect them to see if that makes the video quality better.
